A student must earn a minimum 15 points out of 20 points to be considered by the selection committee for final approval into National Honor Society.

Category III: SERVICE Project/Community Activities (a minimum of 2 points required)
(Minimum of 20 hours at this time in high school career)

$2=$ Meets the minimum (20-25 hours)
4 = Above the minimum (more than 25 hours)
Category IV: Recognition and Awards (a minimum of 1 point required)
(Minimum of 2 recognitions/awards in high school career)
Scoring: $\quad 0=$ Does not meet minimum
$1=$ Meets the minimum
$2=$ Above the minimum (more than 2)

## Category V: Essay

(Essay response should include what project, who to be helped, when the project will be done, how to motivate others, what other organizations to include, and why this project is important)
Scoring: $\quad 0=$ Completed but did not address all elements of the question
$1=$ Completed, addressed the question, but with vague explanations
2 = Completed, well written, provided at least 3 applicable specific examples
Category VI: Character - Infinite Campus Behavior (a minimum of 1 point required)
Scoring: $\quad 0=$ Does not meet the minimum - poor classroom behavior, multiple discipline write-ups which include Class Two and above (within the last 2 years)
$1=$ Meets the minimum-good classroom behavior, no discipline write-ups above a Class Two with no multiple behavior events (within the last 2 years)
$2=$ Above the minimum-good classroom behavior, no discipline write-ups above a
Class One with no multiple behavior events (within the last 2 years)
Category VII: Adult Recommendations (One must be from a WCHS faculty member or activities coach/supervisor)
Scoring: $\quad 0=$ Two recommendation forms not submitted and/or recommendation forms
contain a poor rating, multiple average ratings, or at least one specific
"no" recommendation for NHS admission
$1=$ Recommendations contain above average marks to excellent marks and
contain 2 specific "yes" recommendations for NHS admission
2 = All marks/Nearly all marks are excellent and contain 2 specific "yes"
recommendations for NHS admission
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
